Breakfast for any child experiencing food insecurity can be valuable and effective morning tool.

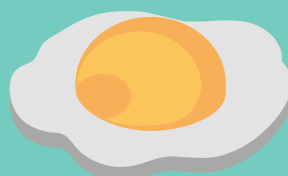

Established in 1992, the Wilbur May Foundation is an independent non-profit organization that aims their spotlight on children and youth services, education, health institutions and recreational services.



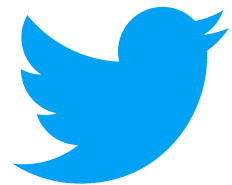
